

Dear Discovery and Adventure Ranger parents,

February 18th brings the Ranger Commanders another chance to bring the boys on a trip and give them a new experience outside of the church. We are looking forward to the possibility of taking the kids to “The Climbing Place” in Fayetteville, N.C. The boys will not only have a chance to free climb for about 4 hours but also learn how to harness in and get a belay class if they find the courage to go a little higher on the walls. The Climbing Place is an 18,000 square foot climbing surface facility and is the largest indoor rock climbing center in North Carolina. It offers over 40,000 climbing holds, 60 top ropes, a massive overhang area, a 300 foot gym traverse and thousands of square feet of bouldering surface as well as a top-out boulder.

Our current plan is to leave Saturday morning on February 18th at 800 am. We will be taking the commanders personal vehicles for the trip. The drive will be a 2 hour trip without traffic. The boys will have 4 hours of climbing time. We will either get lunch around noon or if the boys are engaged in their activities we will get lunch after we complete our climb. We would appreciate you providing the boys with breakfast that morning and money for lunch. We plan on having the boys back to the church at 6 pm. We are asking that you would provide 20\$ for your child in order to cover the cost of registration and gas.

Please let us know if your son will be attending this trip as soon as possible so that we might proceed with confirming this day and completing our payment. We are grateful for the time you give us with your boys and look forward to another great event!
