1. Getting Personal: What was your 2012 Resolution? Have you been able to keep it so far?

2. Prime the Pump: As you reflect on the sermon, what one principle or insight stands out as being particularly helpful, insightful or difficult to grasp?

3. Refocusing: In talking about the “ilife” and living an intentional life in hot pursuit of your potential in Jesus Christ ...what are you excited about right now? What goal are you moving towards this year? I encourage you to write this down if you haven’t already done so.

4. Read Psalm 139:13-16. You are special and unique; handmade by God. Let that revelation sink into your very soul. Now read Matthew 19:26 and Romans 8:31. You CAN accomplish what God has planned for you this year!

5. Are you chicken or are you a pig? You might be a little of both. Maybe you are really strong and in hot pursuit of what God wants in one area of your life, but only giving a part of yourself in another. If you are withholding something from God, pray for help in laying it down.

6. Read Philippians 1:21. We can all use a little more humility and little more obedience to God whether you have been serving God for many years or a few months. The only way to improve in these areas is to dive into the “idie” mentality and surrender to God in prayer and reading His Word. Will you commit to doing that this week? If you do not have a friend or an accountability partner to share these commitments with and pray with, ask your Life Group leader and they will help you.
